

2025 Stormwater Compliance Checklist For CA Industrial Facilities Under the IGP

Annual Reporting Requirements (Due July 15, 2025)

- All sampling results entered for the 2024–2025 monitoring year on SMARTS
- Legally Responsible Person (LRP) certified all pending results
- Annual Report submitted by July 15, 2025
- O Exceedance Response Action (ERA) status updated by Water Board

Sampling & Monitoring (New Stormwater Year: 7/1/25 –6/30/26)

- Assign trained personnel to conduct sampling during qualifying storm events
- O Store monthly observations, samples and analysis reports for recordkeeping
- O Check that all sampling equipment is calibrated and functional

Exceedance Response Action Reports (ERA Season)

- O Level 1 ERA: Complete ERA Evaluation by October 1, 2025
- Level 1 ERA: Identify additional BMPs to address NAL exceedances
- Level 1 ERA: Update SWPPP accordingly
- O Level 2 ERA: Submit ERA Action Plan by January 1, 2026
- Level 2 ERA: Prepare for a Technical Report by a QISP or P.E.
- Level 2 ERA: Implement structural BMPs and treatment systems as needed

BMPs (Best Management Practices)

- O Inspect and maintain all installed BMPs regularly
- O Update and document operational and structural BMPs in your SWPPP
- O Train staff on good housekeeping, spill response, and stormwater awareness
- Evaluate need for upgraded treatment or filtration systems

Documentation & Plans

- SWPPP (Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan) is current and accurate
- Site Map includes all discharge points and monitoring locations
- Employee training logs are up to date
- O Inspection logs are completed and stored for minimum 5 years
- All documents accessible for onsite inspections or audits
