We file a comprehensive report by **January 1 of Year 2**, covering pollution sources, BMPs, costs, and more.

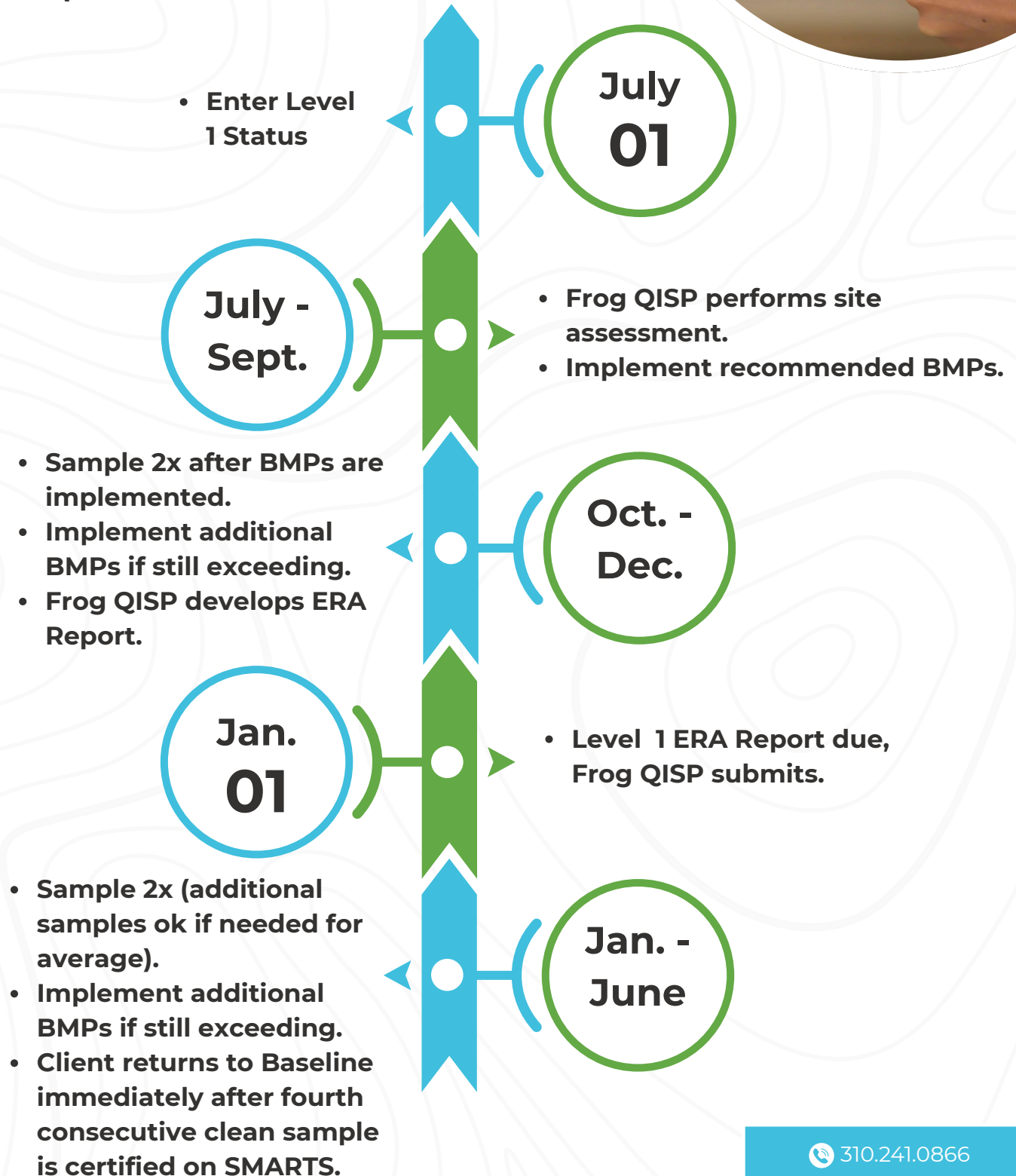

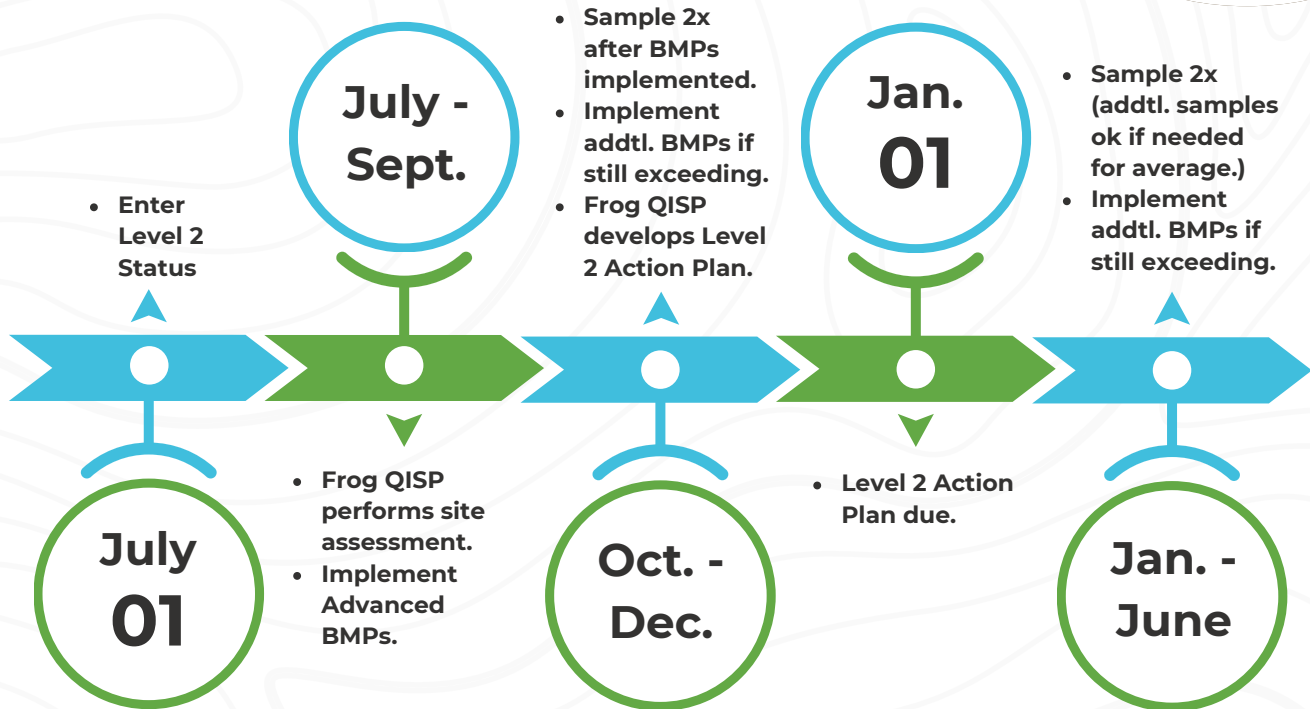
Level 1 Timeline
